During the event itself, in addition to making all announcements, presiding over the receiving line, announcing speeches and toasts, the Master of Ceremonies is a calming influence, remaining unobtrusive, inspiring confidence, and keeping always a watchful eye for the little things that need attention for the event to run flawlessly.

A good Master of Ceremonies will always gauge how formal or otherwise the event needs to be, and can alter his delivery to be as formal or humorous as the situation demands. And, of course, the distinctive uniform of the Master of Ceremonies, and their flair for public speaking, add gravitas, pomp and spectacle to your event

Peter's an intermediate French and Italian speaker, and therefore able to preside over events where correct pronunciation of names and announcements in these languages is of paramount importance. Peter's also able to correctly pronounce Arabic names and honorifics, and would welcome the opportunity to attend any event where correct Arabic pronunciation is needed.
